Northland and Kalitta Air Sponsor Free Veterans Lunch

Northland Area Federal Credit Union in partnership with Kalitta Air, recently provided a free Veterans appreciation luncheon to honor those in the armed forces.

Northland, which was once part of Wurtsmith Air Force Base (Kalitta Air now resides there) continues its bond with Veterans by providing access to special services such as financial education, transitional housing access and more.

The event included free haircuts, a home cooked turkey dinner, Veterans benefits representatives, guest speakers, Oscoda High School Music Students singing the national anthem and a 50th anniversary Vietnam War Veteran pinning ceremony. About 100 Veterans gathered at the American Legion Post #274 in Oscoda, MI for this first year event.

A local Veteran who attended the event said, "As a Lieutenant who was with a heavy artillery battalion in the central highlands of Vietnam during 1968-1969, the pinning program recognizing the 50th anniversary of the war was particularly meaningful."
