Report from the Nominating Committee

On December 17th, 2020 the Nominating Committee of Northland Area Federal Credit Union met for the sole purpose of nominating two people to fill two three-year terms on Northland Area FCU's Board of Directors that are about to expire.

The Nominating Committee members in attendance were: Eileen Koutny - Board of Directors, Nominating Committee Chair, Dorothy Fern - Supervisory Committee Chair, Member and Judy Sharma – Member.

The two Members whose terms will be expiring, are Jean Thomas and Tom Thompson. The Nominating Committee received two letters requesting consideration for nomination to the Board of Directors.

Having received no other requests for consideration the committee hereby recommends Jean Thomas and Tom Thompson for nomination to the Board of Directors.

Nominations for vacancies on the Board of Directors may also be made by petition signed by 1% of the membership. Petitions may be obtained through February 28th, 2021 from the President's office.

Completed petitions must be received by the President's office no later than 5:00 pm on February 28th, 2021. The election will not be conducted by ballot when the number of nominees equals the number of positions to be filled. Nominations will not be accepted from the floor at the Annual Meeting on May 22, 2021.
